Alberta Transportation has had the opportunity to observe the Road Badger in field trials and has reviewed the information provided on the EnCana trials. Based upon these observations and review the department believes there is a valuable role for the Road Badger equipment in the maintenance of gravel and dust controlled road surfaces.

The Road Badger addresses many gravel road maintenance concerns in a cost effective manner. In addition, the reclamation of a non-renewable resource (gravel) will reduce the costs of ongoing maintenance particularly in gravel scarce areas.

Because the department delivers its mandate through private sector contracting we do not purchase construction machinery. However, jurisdictions that continue to deliver construction and maintenance activities for gravel roadways with their own resources may find the Road Badger to be a desirable piece of equipment to complement their existing fleet.

The department believes you have developed a viable piece of equipment and wishes you all the best in marketing the product to the road maintenance industry.
